WINNIPEG, Oct. 30 — (CP) — More gains showed at the close in the coarse grain futures prices today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Losses showed in early trade.

An aggressive demand appeared because of poor harvest weather an upturn on the United States market.

Shipping interests and American accounts bought oats and barley. Local interests took flax and some American buying was indicated in rye.

Offerings increased in late trading. Early gains were reduced at the close.

Reports of overnight loadings of Canadian wheat totalled 2,120,000 bushels. They were: United Kingdom, 500,000; Eire, 370,000; India, 363,000; Switzerland, 300,000; Netherlands, 112,000; Belgium, 80,000 and Norway, 85,000.

Prices for class two wheat were 49 1/2 cent and for I. W. A. were down 1/2 cent. Trading was fairly active.
