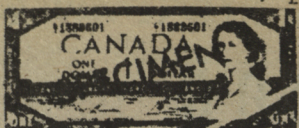

ATTENTION GRADUATE STUDENTS

GERMAN MARSHALL FUND FELLOW-SHIP PROGRAM - 1978

The Fund will award fellowships to scholars and professionals whose proposed research projects promise to contribute to a better understanding and resolution of significant contemporary and emerging problems, domestic and international, common to industrial societies - particularly their comparative political, economic and social aspects. In all cases, projects must have U.S. and European (Western and/or Eastern) components, but may also be concerned with other societies.

DEADLINE NOVEMBER 30.

BELGIAN GOVERNMENT FELLOWSHIPS 1978-79

Postgraduate university study in Art Education, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology, Zoology, Botany, Geology, Physical Geography, Applied Science, Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, Pharmacy, Agronomy, Social Sciences, including Political Science and Economics, Law, Philosophy, Philology, History, Psychology and Teaching.

DEADLINE NOVEMBER 30.

COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS

Tenable in Ghana, Hong

Kong, India, Jamaica, Malaysia, Nigeria, Sri Lanka, Trinidad & Tobago, and the United Kingdom.

The Value of the award, which includes travel expenses, is designed to cover the living costs and study costs of a scholar during tenure of the award.

DEADLINE OCTOBER 31.

I.O.D.E. SCHOLARSHIPS

Post-graduate study in History, Economics, Constitutional Government, the Humanities, or any subject vital to the interests of the Commonwealth. Payment of \$5,000 in Canadian funds will be made in three installments

DEADLINE DECEMBER 15.

FRANK KNOX MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIPS

Study at Harvard University in: Arts and Sciences, (including Engineering), Business Administration, Design, Divinity, Education, Law, Public Administration, Medicine, Dental Medicine and Public Health. Valued at \$3,400 plus tuition fees.
