101 But Says Life Still Sweet

ROCKVILLE, Ind. (AP)—"Life is still sweet," says Arthur A. Hargrave, reported to be the oldest newspaper publisher in the United States.

Hargrave, owner of the weekly Rockville Republican for nearly 70 years and still an active writer, Thursday observed his 101st birthday anniversary quietly in his home with three of his five children.

Although failing sight and hearing have kept him from the office for almost three years, Hargrave continues to turn out his column, Club Man's Talk, as he has every issue for more than 50 years.

"Several people have asked me what a centenarian thinks about as his birthday approaches," the publisher wrote in Thursday's column.

"Life is still sweet, and God has abundantly blessed me every day of my life—in business and in my family — so actually 101 years seems a very short time."

Hargrave began in the newspaper field as a printer's apprentice at 16. He bought the Republican in 1888 and has contributed something to every issue since that time.

On his philosophy of life, Hargrave said: "None of us is right all the time, but I never wasted any time on remorse."

Mr. Buckley has been a leading Conservative figure in Cape Breton politics for many years.

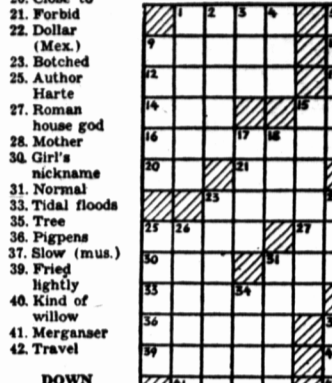

down, the hand does have some points of interest worth recording. Johnny Crawford was my partner and despite his vaunted prowess, I did not consider my hand worth responding to his club bid. South couldn't see his way clear to selling out so cheaply and bid a spade. Crawford took a similar view with respect to one spade—he had pretty good groceries to back his opinion—and made an informative double. North was kind enough to save me from a bidding dilemma by inserting a two diamond bid.

This rolled around to Crawford who, oblivious to the miserable predicament I was in, doubled for takeout again. I greeted this action with a feeling of utter despair. He apparently wanted me to bid a suit, but South had already named my long suit; I couldn't very well bid three clubs, Crawford's suit, with my meager club holding; nor could I pass with the expectation of beating two diamonds.

Faced with an impossible choice, I decided to pass. South wouldn't go for this and bid two spades. Again Crawford doubled. He just wouldn't let go. By now I had decided I'd teach him a lesson, so I passed. When the smoke had cleared we found South was four tricks short of his contract. Total 700.

At the other table, the Swedish-East-West pair got to three no-trump, down 50. U. S. gain—750 points.

FLU HITS FLEET MADRID (Reuters) An outbreak of Asiatic flu was reported Wednesday aboard ships of the United States 6th Fleet now off the southern coast of Spain. A scheduled amphibious demonstration, to have been held off the town of Almeria, has been cancelled to prevent exposing Spaniards to the disease. So far there have been no cases in Spain.
