LONDON, Sept. 24 - (Reuters) - Export of agricultural machinery from the Commonwealth countries has increased from 15 per cent of the world total in 1938 to 33-1/2 per cent in 1951, a survey issued today by the Commonwealth economic committee showed.

Table with columns: The 1951 exports represented more than \$800,000,000 against about \$67,500,000 in 1938, the survey said. The survey said Britain now is the second largest manufacturer of tractors in the world with 2,191 output of 178,000 against 791,000 in the U.S.
