Bayonne was drawn for the third heat and Prudence He came home with Keppoch Playgirl and Shining Hour on her heels to give one of the biggest payoffs of the evening on a card notable for the absence of big payoffs.

Jollity George had no trouble at all in winning the first heat of the 3-year-old pace and led Mr. Scarlet and Cottage Frank to the wire with plenty to spare. In the second go, however, it was a much different story and Eric Moreside had to drive the chestnut gelding full tilt down the stretch to edge Mr. Scarlet by a whisker. Suspense finished third.

An added moment of excitement occurred when Canadair broke away from his driver just as the horses were going to the post in the second dash of the 3-year-old pace and raced around the track without a driver. A quick warning to the operators of the starting gate by announcer Frank Aern saved what could possibly have been a bad accident and as the horse rounded the turn completing his first lap he crashed the sulky in on the inner rail, splintering it. Roach MacGregor caught up to the runaway horse on his second round and managed after a struggle to pull him up.
