Consider Power To Ban Appeals To The Supreme Court

OTTAWA, June 21.—(CP)—Six judges of the Supreme Court of Canada tonight have under consideration the power of the Parliament of Canada to abolish appeals to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council. Should they decide parliament has the power, should their decision be upheld by the Judicial Committee itself and should parliament exercise the power, the Supreme Court would become the court of last resort for all Canadian matters.
