Proposes Study Of Grade 9 Students

TORONTO (CP)—A leading education expert Monday proposed a Canada-wide study of grade 9 students "to conserve our human resources."
Dr. R. W. B. Jackson told secondary school headmasters attending the 96th annual convention of the Ontario Educational Association that the time has come to replace "opinions" with "facts" in the study and research of education problems.
Dr. Jackson, assistant director of the Ontario College of Education research department, said less than half the province's gifted children complete secondary school.
He was backed by Dr. Sidney Smith, president of the University of Toronto, who said universities want all the eligible students they can get but also would like to exclude many now attending who cannot make the grade.
He criticized parents who push their offspring into universities even though the youngsters may not be suitable.
"There are other ways to good citizenship than through a university or college degree," he said.
Dr. Smith said all seven Canadian universities have too high a failure rate in the first year.


