The different reports showed the order to be in a very good condition. The number of members reported was 1284. The receipts of the year were \$375.18 and the balance in treasury at close of the year \$37.43. The juvenile department showed substantial increase during the year. On the evening of the 7th a public temperance meeting was held, at which stirring temperance addresses were given. There was a fair attendance. The next annual session will be held at Charlottetown; the semi-annual session at Wilmot Valley.

An Important Tunnel.

The greatest engineering feat in the history of the anthracite coal mining is about to begin. It is the commencement of what will be known as the Jeddo Tunnel, which will be driven for the purpose of draining the flooded mines of Jeddo and Harleigh. It will be constructed from Butler Valley, Pa., to the bottom of Elzevade mammoth vein, a distance of three miles through solid rock, to be 8 feet square in the clear. The scheme of tunneling through the mountain first occurred to John Markle, who is to be president of the company, which will bear the title of the Jeddo Tunnel Co., Limited. It will open an inexhaustible supply of coal and furnish employment for thousands of people for many years to come. It will also serve the double purpose of draining all the collieries in the valley.

The British board of trade show an expanded Anglo-Canadian trade.
