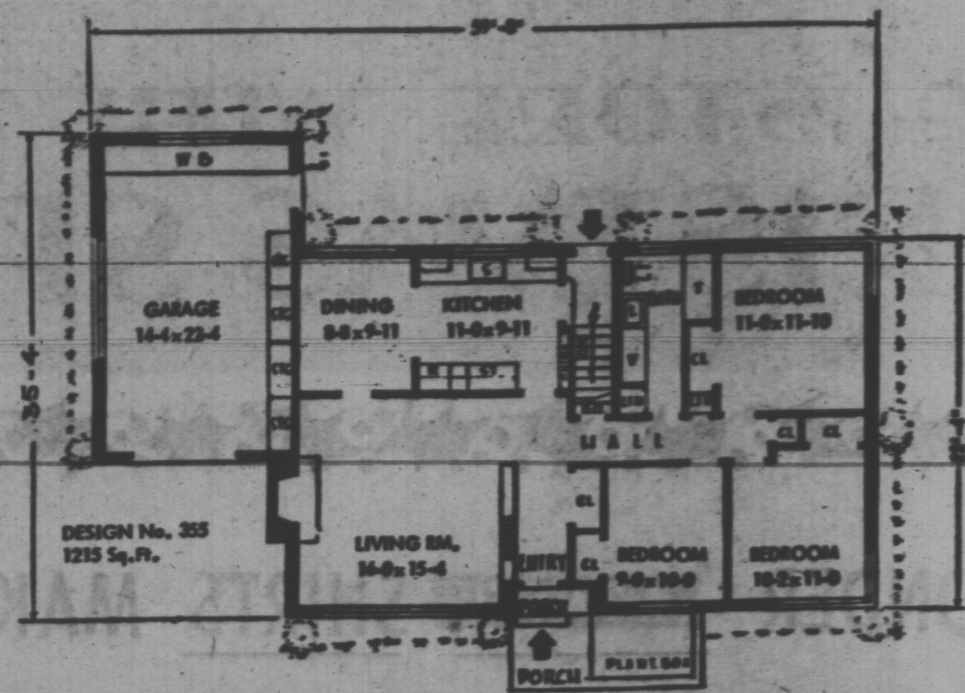
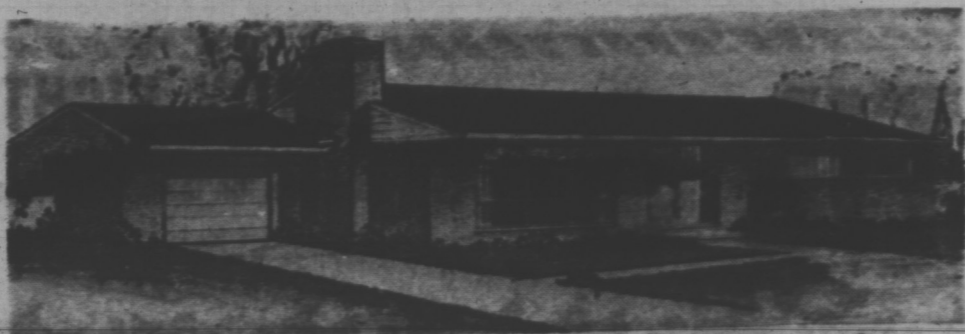

HOW TO OBTAIN DESIGN BOOK

The latest design book entitled "181 Selected Suburban and Country Homes Designed for Canadians," is now available at the offices of The Guardian and The Evening Patriot for \$1, tax free. This new volume includes color selection, etc., plus over 100 popular new designs to choose from. Also included are full designs of how to order blueprints.

QUESTION: The bottom outside corner tends to catch on the threshold. Both hinges seem tight and firm. Before I try to make it fit by planing off the corners enough, I'd be pleased to hear if there's anything else I could try first.

ANSWER: Don't plane, until all else has failed. It will only result in gaps you'll never be able to fill. Even though the hinges appear tight, the top end may be out too far. Try to pull back the top of the door toward the hinge by cutting a deeper mortise in the frame behind the upper hinge plate. So when you replace the hinge plate, it will be recessed deeper into the frame, and consequently will pull the top of the door toward the hinge.

QUESTION: I would like to change the color scheme in the kitchen of an old house we bought. At present it has grey wallpaper, apparently quite solid. Can I paint over this without too long. Unless you clean off the grey film, the paint will start flaking off: it won't adhere unless a surface is free of grease. Wipe the paper vigorously with fine steel wool and turpentine, or use a prepared wallpaper cleaner, available at hardware and housewares stores. Sure, it's more work. But when you take all the time and trouble to paint a room, you might as well have the paint stick on for a few years, seems to me.

QUESTION: Can a glass-lined hot water tank become so worn that water flows out rusty? Ours is only eight years old. Now I have to drain a couple of gallons daily, to eliminate sediment. Even so, my laundry gets stained from iron deposit.

ANSWER: Don't blame the glass liner. It could be that the pipe leading in is rusty, or even there's just a rusty connection the water flows by. Or the same condition could exist between the tank and the faucet. A filter might give temporary relief. But the owner you can have a capable plumber replace the rust-producing pipes or connections, the better.

QUESTION: In the house I am planning, all the woodwork, will be select white birch. Since the slightly brownish-yellow color of birch, what about this idea: Seal the wood with white shellac, followed by two finishing coats of clear satin varnish. Will this keep the wood looking light and natural?

ANSWER: All wood will darken with age, regardless of the finish. But your idea would certainly keep the birch light-colored as long as any other method I know.

QUESTION: Is there any special treatment I should give a new piano when I leave it in a house closed for the rest of the winter?

ANSWER: Nothing necessary, under normal conditions. If a house is apt to be unusually damp, due to location, many people stuff the case with crumpled newspapers to absorb the dampness, and keep it out of the felt. Others claim this concentrates the dampness and holds it against the strings. My preference is to leave things as is.

QUESTION: Our summer cottage has gypsum board walls, hollow between studs. Also it has a three-quarter basement. Would it be practical to winterize this cottage? If so, how do I go about it?

ANSWER: Many such a cottage has been winterized before, friend. What you're talking about is insulation in the wall space, under the floor and under the roof. All you need is a go-around estimate from a good builder. Get two or three, while you're at it, so you can judge.

QUESTION: Thanks to your formula, succeeded in removing rust stains around the base of the wrought-iron railings in my concrete steps. One thing I neglected to ask in my previous question: How do I prevent more rusting?

ANSWER: Be sure that every square millimeter of the iron railings have a coat of paint. First, sand off any loose, flaky rust, then apply a rust-inhibiting primer. Follow with a finish made for exposed metal. Main thing: Don't let rain or snow get at bare metal.

QUESTION: We recently built a year-round home, using panel doors throughout. We were assured they had been properly dried before delivery. However, we find the panels are shrinking - as much as one quarter inch all around. Our leather staves there is insufficient moisture in the house. On his advice, we installed a humidifier, which the heating people say is right for our size house. But the situation hasn't been helped. Do you think these doors were properly dried, or did we get doors made of green lumber?

ANSWER: From your description it seems to me someone is kidding about how thoroughly these doors were dried prior to delivery. Anyone else care to opine?

QUESTION: Accidentally I spilled some cleaner, used for whitening the grout between bathroom floor tiles, in the bath tub. According to the label, this contains phosphoric acid, which has apparently etched our tub. Is there anything which will remove the streaks and roughness? We have already tried sandpaper. How about epoxy paint?

ANSWER: Your query about epoxy paint comes closest, in my opinion, to making the best of a bad situation. Nothing can "etch" a porcelain tub. The paint, in a few coats, may partially fill out some of the roughness and smooth them a bit, as well as hide the streaks. As for a perfect, match with the tub, it's doubtful. So is the permanence of the repair. Worth trying - but it's certainly too bad this had to happen at all.

QUESTION: The top of my front door - all solid wood - sags away from the frame. The frame itself is square. As a re-
