**Allegations
Laughed Off**

DUBLIN (Reuters)—An Irish
peer, the Marquess of Headfort,
laughed off allegations Wednes-
day that—even as a hoax—he
asked a waiter to kill British
Prime Minister Wilson.

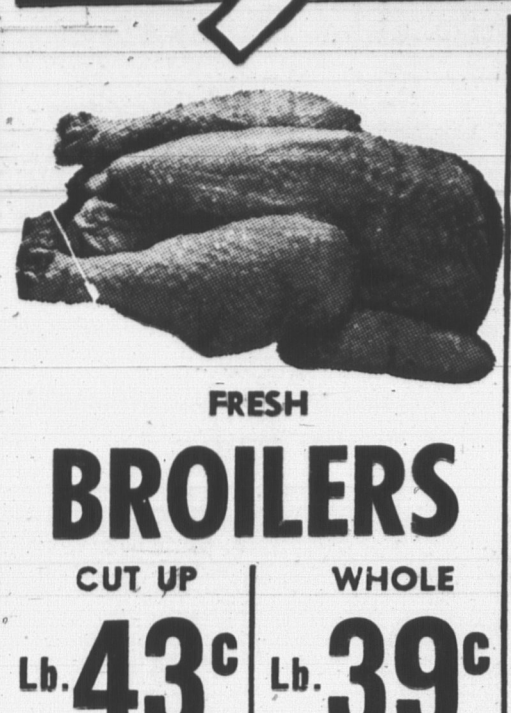
British newspapers headlined
reports that the 33-year-old peer,
said to be an inveterate practi-
cal joker, had been asked by
police Monday to leave the
Silly Isles where Wilson is va-
cating.

The waiter, Ray Youngman,
27, told police on the islands off
the southwest tip of England
that a man hired him to row a
boat. During the trip the man
asked him his political views and
whether he would be willing to
assassinate the prime minister.

In a statement issued from his
home near here the marquess
said:

"The conversation alleged to
have taken place between
Youngman and myself—except
possibly as to the hiring of a
boat—is emphatically denied."

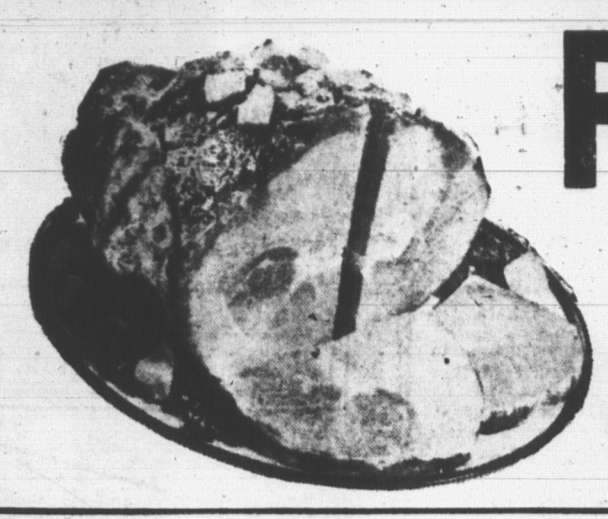
