Vernon Canadiens Score 3-0 Upset Over Dummies

ONTARIO (CP)—Vernon Canadiens perhaps fired up by their benching of himself, as if hockey was going style and cheated-elimination in the Allan Cup finals with shutout of Whittby Dunlops day night.

victory left the best-of-series for Canada's amateur senior hockey championship Whittby's favor and forced a fifth game here Wednesday.

The Dunlops, anticipating a four-game sweep of the set, had made arrangements before the game for a triumphant entry into Whittby, 30 miles east of here, where there was to be a celebration of the club's second cup victory in three years.

FIRST SHUTOUT IN 83

But the Canadiens, who also had made preparations to fly home early Sunday after being sadly outclassed in the first three games, got a fantastic netminding display from beleaguered Hal Gordon and outshone the Dunlops over the first two periods to hand the 1958 world amateur hockey champions their first shutout in 83 games this season.

Right winger Jim Moro, a series standout in a Vernon lineup that so far has had few stars, gave the Canadiens their winning goal at 19:24 of the first period while Whittby's Jack Kane was in the penalty box for elbowing. Defenceman Tom Stecyk added an insurance marker at 4:12 of the second on a 15-footer that threaded the narrow opening between netminder John Henderson and the goal post on the short side. Moro helped set up the goal.

Left winger Merv Bidoak finished it off at 14:05 of the second, scoring on a rebound after Walt Trentini had tested Henderson twice.

Gordon, lustily cheered several times by the sparse crowd of 2,762 fans, was brilliant. He made a total of 45 saves—21 in the third period—while Henderson was called on for only 20 stops.
