U.S. 'Copters Aid Thailand

WASHINGTON (Reuters) — The state department has confirmed for the first time that United States helicopter units are helping Thailand in its anti-guerrilla war in the north-eastern part of that country. Department spokesman Robert McCloskey told a press conference the operations are being conducted at the Thai government's request and do not actually involve American personnel in combat.
