The amount arrived at should be settled in family conference.

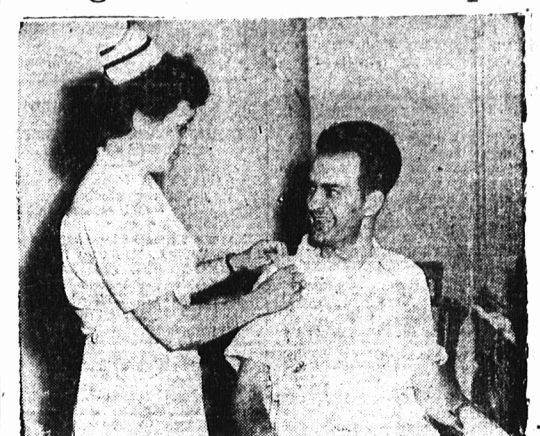
