Wow! What can you say? The Panther finally put it all together! Hitting on all cylinders, there was just no way we could be stopped. With Grant Canvin at the controls, the offense was superb, ripping off 270 yards rushing and 232 yards through the air.

Canvin was 14 for 28 in passing and two for touchdowns, one being a 71 yard combination with Bill Simmons early in the game which really brought the crowd to its feet and set to tone for the rest of the game. Dick Yost and Jack Myron twin-barrels of a 10 guage shot gun. Yost the Gallopin Ghost. piled up 112 yards in 12 carries for a 9.3 yard average gain and scored one of our touchdowns in the third quarter. Jack Myron, playing one of the best games of his career, ran for 154 yds. The offensive line should also be singled out for much of the praise as they opened gapping holes in the Dal. defense.

In the air, Canvin relied heavily on Gerry Campbell and Glen Claybourne. They were good for 90 yds. 53yds. respectively and Campbell scored the final touchdown. Al Stoddard was high scorer in the game, however, as his dependable toe was good for three converts and two field goals of 18 yds. each. Mike Reid, used exclusively in a punting role, averaged 37.5 yds. per punt.

And if you think the offense was good just think what the defense did. With the help of Murray, Sprague, Hebermhl and Thompson they simply over-powered the Dal. team.

It was the outstanding work of Stoddard and Crossman on the right side, however, that really drew raves. Stoddard especially was instrumental in the victory, making key tackles late in the second quarter to demoralize the Tiger's offense.



If the Panthers can play this type of football consistently, the odds against a "miracle finish" will quickly diminish. This Sat. we meet Mt. Allison in Sackville at 1:30 P.M. Games against Mt.
