Labor Wants Judge Moved

VANCOUVER (CP) — Two union locals have demanded the federal government remove Mr. Justice A. M. Manson from the British Columbia Supreme Court bench. The demands of Local 138 of the Brotherhood of Painters, decorators and Paperhangers of America (CLC) and Local 433 of the International Pulp, Sulphite and Paper Mill Workers (CLC) were made known Wednesday night at a meeting of the Vancouver Labor Council (CLC). The demands follow Mr. Justice Manson's actions in court proceedings against the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Ironworkers (CLC) which has struck several B.C. projects including the \$23,000,000 Second Narrows Bridge across Vancouver harbor.

Confusion Try Is Charge Laid

VANCOUVER (CP)—Attorney-General Bonner said Wednesday efforts to link British Columbia's Trade Union Act to the province's labor unrest are "merely a calculated attempt to confuse the public." He was commenting on a request Tuesday night by the B.C. Federation of Labor (CLC) for a meeting to discuss the act. In a wire to Mr. Bonner and Labor Minister Wicks the 200,000-member federation said since the act was passed "more injunctions have been granted in B.C., more trade unionists have been brought before the courts, than in the other nine provinces combined."
