NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market backed away from high ground for the year Monday in a late decline.

Prices were mixed or a shade higher until selling got under way in the final half hour.

Some leading stocks closed fractions to a point or so lower. Gains were mostly under a point.

Brokers generally attributed the performance in the final half hour to technical factors. The day's news was mostly bearish. Several concerns cut dividends.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks fell 50 cents from its 1958 high to \$166.60.

Among Canadian issues, International Nickel dropped 1/2%. Canadian Pacific was unchanged. Aluminum Ltd. was off 3/4%.

Canadian issues on the American exchange included Brazilian Traction, unchanged; Preston East Dome, down 1/4%; Fargo Oil, up 1-16; and Sapphire Petroleum, up 1-16.
