Cup, saucer spectacle to be bigger, better

The Gold Cup and Saucer Parade is coming to town. Said last year, these words only roused the curiosity of citizens. The same words said this year get a far different reaction from spectators because last year's spectacle is still fresh in their memories and they are looking forward to a real treat on Friday morning of this week.

They'll get it too, because this year's parade will surpass anything ever seen in Charlotte-town in the way of parades, the Gold Cup and Saucer Committee says.

It will be bigger than the 1962 extravaganza seen by a crowd estimated by police in the vicinity of 20,000. These include three pipe bands and five brass bands.

The bands too will be entered in a competition in various classifications, brass, pipes and youth bands. The out of province bands participating include the Balmoral Girls Pipers from Stellarton, N.S. and the Fredrickton Air Cadet Band from Fredrickton, N.B.

The Balmoral girls are newcomers to the parade, but the Fredrickton outfit with its precision drill team was seen last year, was well received and was good enough to win a prize in the youth band classification.

Six local bands will take care of the rest of the musical program. These will be led by the fine band of the Prince Edward Island Regiment under Lt. Charles E. MacGregor.

The Regiment was judged top band in last year's parade in earlier this year the float for

the second year in a row was voted as the top float. In the Lobster Carnival Float Parade in Summerside and last year won the top award in the Gold Cup and Saucer Parade. In recent weeks it appeared in a big float parade in Ellsworth, Me., and has been seen all over Canada through participating in the great Grey Cup Parade in Toronto last year.

However, there will be many other floats entered this year that will give the big city float a run for its money in the judging.

The outstanding air force float from RCAF Station, Summerside, will also be participating and will include their own color party. Two highly rated high school bands are also entered, these are the Queen's High School and Birchwood High School outfits.

Island pipe bands to be heard include the Lovat Scots Pipe Band under Pipe Major George A. Fraser and the Burke's Lads and Lassies Band under Pipe Major Wilfred Burke.

One of the great new attractions of this year's Parade is the addition of nationally known television star *George Sullivan* appearing through courtesy of *du Maurier Cigarettes*. Miss Sullivan will make several appearances during her two-day stay here and one of the highlights will be her appearance in the parade in a gleaming five engine red convertible.

TO GIVE CONCERT Also, she will be heard in a 10 to 15 minute stage performance in the evening at the Charlotte-town Driving Park.

Another addition are the 14 high stepping majorettes from Yarmouth, N.S. Their appearance here is being sponsored by the City of Charlottetown as its contribution to the success of the parade.

Still another new addition are the clowns. These will include a horse, Barnab, 'Nod' Hoar, Goldlocks and the Three Bears and a host of other fairland amuse young and old alike.

But hold on, that isn't all. The navy will be in town this week, too, and will be well represented in the parade with two smart stepping marching units. One unit will come from the three Royal Canadian Navy frigates that will be in port (the Port Eriks, Lanark and New Waterford), and the other from the American submarine Sea Owl.

Pope Paul forms 'Peace Foundation'

VATICAN CITY (AP) — The Vatican announced today the establishment of a Pope John XXIII Peace Foundation to award a prize every three years for efforts toward world peace.

The foundation will be set up with the \$10,000 peace prize Pope John received from the Balzan Foundation last May for his peace efforts, three weeks before his death.

The original fund is expected to be increased by contributions from donors, the Vatican press office said.

At the time he received his Balzan prize Pope John said the money would go into "a perpetual fund for peace."
