Last year's was thought to be tops, but this year the new performers surpass even that tremendous show. They are out of this world, and you will love every minute of it and every performer in it. They are not just a series of acts but a whole panorama of entertainment wrapped into one hour and then electrically charged to make you yell and scream your approval. Pete and Bob open the show with an oldtime slapstick clown routine and then go into a swinging act on the single bar that is something special with one of the smartest double swings we have seen in a long time. The boys get the show off to a swinging start that is full of oldtime comedy.

**TRICK JUGGLING**  
The Canestrelli Family will let you see some of the finest trick juggling you have watched in a long time and then top it with a special balancing act on the top of a wandering ladder that moves all over the stage. Don't miss this one.

Willie and Joe do the bicycle act and it turns out to be a straight balancing act—but with what a difference. The bike is 12 feet up in the air on the top of a narrow stand. If you like your thrills mixed with chills this is for you.

**NOT STRANGERS**  
Spotted just halfway through the show is one of the world's best known groups, Rich, Gibson and Rich. They are not strangers, as they took the town by storm seven years ago. They were good, then, but they could open and close the show and play all the parts in the middle and the crowd would love it.

Last night the big crowd went wild as the youngest member of the family the used to be known as Little Rich gave a really fantastic performance on the drums. Jimmy Rich is truly one of the greatest drummers we have ever heard and since he is only 17, well, so far in the musical world. But in that world he had good teachers as his mother and father, the Rich and Gibson part of the team, are top musicians and play the marimba the way it should be played but seldom is. But even there young Jimmy gets into the act on that precision instrument—and the family plays as a team that even Chicago Bears couldn't stop. Their drumming is something else that has to be seen to be believed.

The Wilson dog act is a crowd pleaser that the children will really go for. But adults are due for a thrill as well as they will witness something seldom seen and that is a dog, a beautiful German Shepherd, extremely well trained, who jumps through a ring of fire and does it with out a scratch.

Everyone young and old will love the Roger Family of a mother and three blonde daughters in a tumbling act that is something new. The fantastic mother alone is something you

should not miss as she literally carries the load in a display of strength seldom seen on any stage.

And then come the Chesterfields to close the show. There is no question that this is one of the world's best trampoline acts that offers everything from

thrills to comedy falls. But the almost unbelievable wind up sees the son doing a triple twist turn in the air and land solidly standing up on his father's shoulders. There are other things you never saw before to make this an act you will not soon forget.

**President Announces Objective**

A. Walthor Gaudet, president of the Prince Edward Island United Fund Campaign announced yesterday that an objective of \$258,191 has been set for the fall campaign.

This total was announced by the president after a series of meetings of the budget committee and the board of directors.

In his statement to the press yesterday, Mr. Gaudet noted that this was a reduction from last year's objective but an increase of almost six per cent over the actual amount raised. He said that there is a need for more work to be done in all phases of agency service supported by United Fund dollars. It was unfortunate that the fund had been unable to meet these needs fully in the past years, he said.

**HUGE TASK**  
The budget committee, under the chairmanship of Ralph D. Manning, was faced with a huge task when meetings began in early June.

Total agency requests amounted to \$362,180. These requests were based on needed services as seen by agency staff and volunteer board members.

The United Fund budget committee was charged with the job of reducing this total to a figure that was within reach of the campaign.

In addition it had to suggest alternate methods of financing some parts of the programs and ensure that all levels of support were being used to the best advantage.

In his report to the board, Mr. Manning made some specific recommendations in regard to the unmet needs of the agencies.

**THE TOWN PLANNING ACT REGULATIONS**

The Town Planning Act Regulations have been amended to include all that area within 540 feet of the centre line of the Highway between the EASTERN BOUNDARY OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELEANORS to REIDS CORNER and from Wilmot Bridge to the NORTHERN BOUNDARY of Trans Canada Highway at Albany Corner.

Regulations are now effective controlling:  
(1) Subdivision of land  
(2) Location of building on lot  
(3) Changing location of any building

Persons intending to construct or relocate a building in this area are reminded it is necessary in first obtain a permit from this Department. Persons selling building lots must first have a plan of subdivision approved by the Minister.

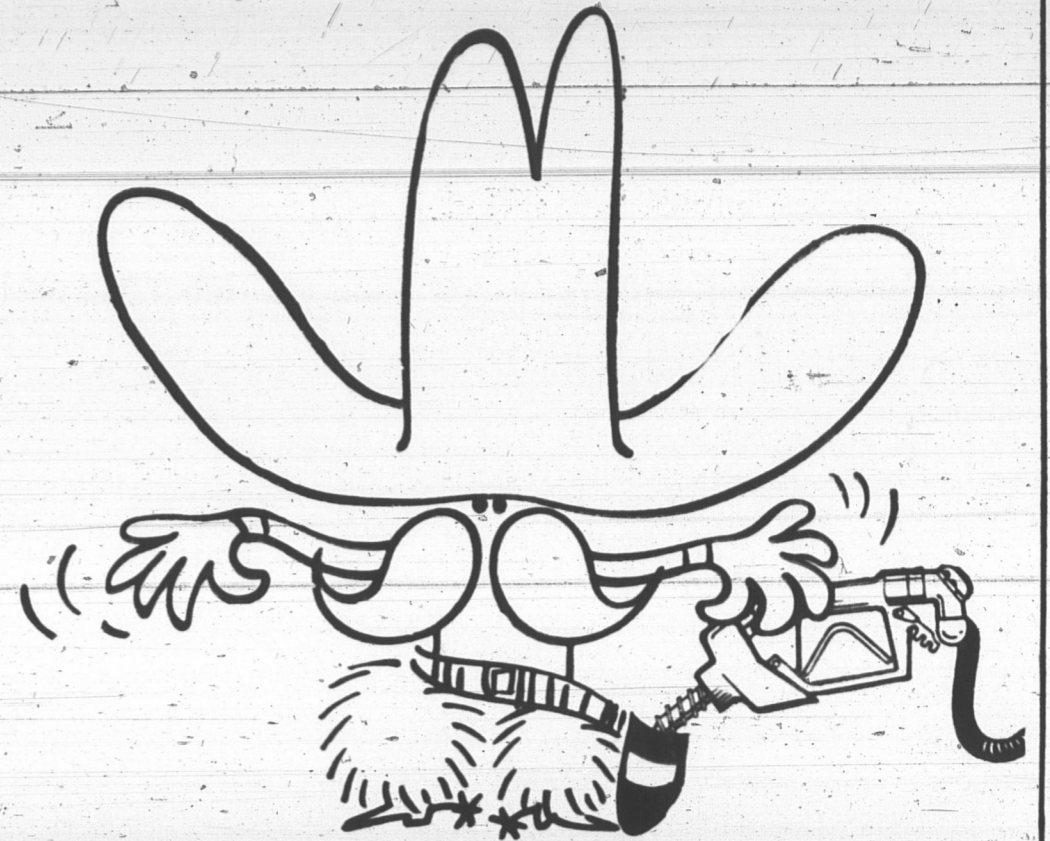
