THE UNIQUE PIECE OF ENGINEERING Never attempted by a mountain stream run over and above a railroad track is a unique piece of engineering that the Southern Pacific Company is shortly to commence near Wright's Station in the Santa Cruz Mountains. DIFFICULT OF PRONUNCIATION.

Some Combinations of Vowels in English which Stagger the Foreigner. For making the s and z the tongue has to be partially applied to a portion of the palate next the teeth, says The Contemporary Review. Not only, however, must the contact be complete, but its place is indefinite. To make sh and zh the contact has to be made, not with the tip, but with the upper surface of the tongue, and must be an incomplete contact. Though for making the liquids the tip of the tongue and the sides of the tongue are used, yet a requisite is not an exact adjustment of the tip, but an imperfect contact with the palate. For the th the tip is used, along with the edges of the tongue, but no perfect adjustment is required, either to the edges of the teeth or to the junction of the teeth with the palate, where the sound may equally well be made. Though for the t and d complete contact of the tip and edges of the tongue with the palate is required, yet the place of contact is not definite and the tip takes no more important share in the action than the sides. Anyone who observes the movements of his tongue in speaking will find that there occur no cases in which the adjustments must have an exactness corresponding to the extreme power of discrimination which the tip possesses; for speech this endowment is useless. Even were it useful it could not be used, for it has been developed by survival of the fittest, for perfect articulation is useful, yet imperfect articulation has rarely such an effect as to impede a man in the maintenance of his life.
