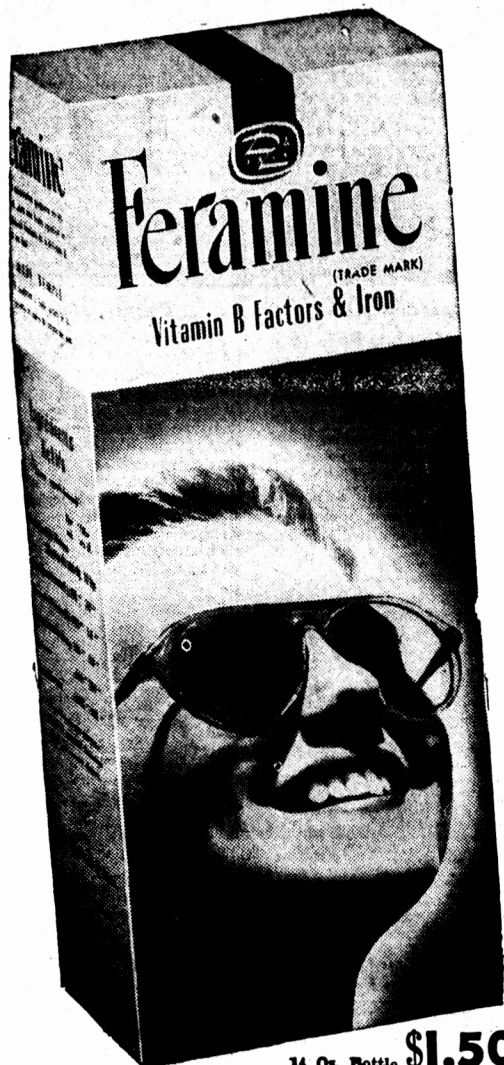

 3 cups sifted Swans Down Flour
 8 teaspoons Calumet Baking Powder
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder and salt; sift together three times. Cream butter, add sugar gradually; cream together until fluffy. Add flour, alternate with egg whites, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth. Add vanilla. Beat egg whites until they will hold up in mountain peaks; beat quickly, but thoroughly into batter. Bake in three evenly 9-inch layer pans in moderate oven (375°) about 20 minutes. Spread lemon icing between layers and over cake.
