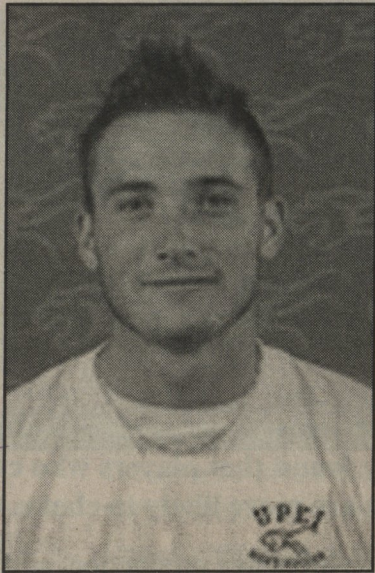


Panther Named AUS and CIS Athlete of the week
