OS petition of 2,900 of the leading ladies and citizens of Montreal the Council has consented to the appointment of a police matron for the searching of female prisoners and similar duties. THE commission sent by the British Government to report on the capabilities of the Dominion for supplying horses for the army, arrived in Quebec on Sunday last by the steamer Parisian.

OVER 200 persons were poisoned by eating ice cream and strawberries at a church festival at Pateraville, N. J., last week. Some are in a critical condition. It is thought the poison was in the sugar. It is reported that a large school of mackerel "struck in" off Covehead yesterday, and that some nine or ten American fishing schooners are busily engaged hauling them in. Where are our fisheries' protection cruisers? MR. MOSES A. DOW, the founder and proprietor of the Waverly Magazine, died at Charlestown, Mass., on the 22nd. He was born at Littleton, N. H., in 1810, and at the age of 14 learned the printing trade. He established the Waverly in 1850 on credit. THE steamer M. A. Starr, Capt. Ferguson, arrived from Halifax and intermediate ports at 5 o'clock this morning with a cargo of sugar, lobsters, etc., and Miss Christy Campbell as a passenger. At midnight of the day after the supposed death, the watchers were startled by a groan. The lid was removed and Daniels was found to be alive. He claims to have been perfectly conscious of everything which passed, but says he was unable to move a muscle.

LAST evening, Chief of Police Flynn received a letter from the General Superintendent of Police, Chicago, requesting him to be on the lookout for a man named Rudolph Schmaubelt, a Socialist, who is "wanted" in Chicago for murder and inciting riot. Schmaubelt (whose photograph is enclosed in the letter) is described as being about 30 years of age, 6 feet high, 190 lbs. weight, and a slightly stoop-shouldered. His hair is of a light-brown color, and he usually wears a full beard, but when he left Chicago his whiskers were shaved off, and he wore a light moustache. He works at making watchmaking tools. Schmaubelt was one of the leading Anarchists who caused the ever-memorable riot and massacre in Chicago on the 4th of last month.

An Extraordinary Crime.

A Paris despatch says that in the village of Groland, on the Rochelle and Niort canal, near the termination of the marshes of La Vendee, two sisters lived in a small cottage. Julie was married to a wood-chopper named Perrin, and the three lived together in poor circumstances. About a month ago an absconding cashier from Paris obtained lodgings in this cottage, and incautiously exposed his money. The unmarried sister conceived the idea of robbing him and going to Paris to set up as a dressmaker. In order to accomplish this she put arsenic in a tumbler of spiced wine she gave the traveller before going to bed. He died in great agony during the night. Finding it impossible to dispose of the body alone, she let her sister into the secret, and they shared the money and carried out the body and concealed it in the marshes. The unmarried sister, whose name is Nannette Fagart, still resolved upon possessing the entire amount, and to carry out her design she made a jar of lemonade a few days ago, and having done this with arsenic she placed it conspicuously on the table where her married sister and her husband would be sure to see it on their return from the fields where they were weeding. The man drank a tumblerful of the mixture and died in a few hours, while the wife, who had only tasted a little, escaped. She got up early in the morning and let herself quietly out of the house, when she ran along the road in the direction of Rochelle until she met a gendarme, to whom she denounced her sister as the murderer of her husband. Upon Nannette being arrested, she told the story of the murder of the Paris cashier, and Mme. Perrin was also arrested, and both are in goal awaiting their trial.
