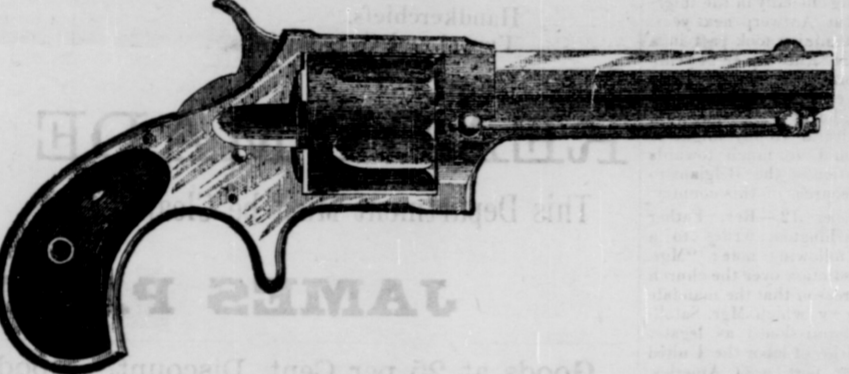

OVER NIAGARA ON A WIRE.

How it Feels to be Carried Across on a Rope Walker's Back. "At the end of a month of practice on a gallows strung between the rocks of two tenements," said Clifford Caterley, the young Niagara rope walker, "I then it was that I determined to cross Niagara." Fortunately I did not lose my head, and caught by my knees and toes as I fell forward. Every one thought I stumbled purposely, and since then I have often taken the dive and caught by my toes.

CANCER IS CURABLE.

REMARKABLE DISCOVERY IN THE TREATMENT OF A DREAD DISEASE. Inoculations of the Virus-Causative of Erysipelas—Hypodermic Injections of the Virus—The Most Malignant Form of Tumor or to Entirely Disappear in a Short Time. This is from The New York World. A patient in the New York Cancer Hospital accidentally became inoculated with the virus of erysipelas several weeks ago. As the disease progressed it was noticed that the patient's cancerous condition improved. This fact suggested Dr. William T. Hall the advisability of inoculating cancer patients with the virus of erysipelas. Accordingly several cases were set apart and experiments were begun and carried out by Dr. W. B. Coley under the direction of Dr. Hall. The inoculations were made not only on patients with carcinoma (commonly known as cancer), but also on others who were suffering from sarcoma, which is a much more malignant form of tumor than carcinoma. The results in both forms were very satisfactory.
