 Canadian issues were mixed. Canadian Pacific added 1/2 and Hiram Walker gained 1/4. Dome Mines slipped 1/4 while McIntyre and Distillers Seagram both lost 1/4.  
 On the American stock exchange Giant Yellowknife advanced 1/2 and Royalite Oil was up 1/4. Lake Shore fell 1/4.
