An increasing number of questions have been raised over the past few months concerning residence rules, regulations, and life styles. I'm sure that you can appreciate the diversity of individual interests which exist in our residences and that it is impossible to satisfy everyone. The University Administration is certainly interested in listening to

the views of all students and would welcome your input on matters which affect the residence life on our campus.

A committee has been established, effective almost immediately, under the chairmanship of Jack Blanchard, a member of our counselling staff, and with Mary Ross, the Head Resident in Marian Hall, also involved. In addition, each Residence House Committee has been asked to select two students who are presently living in residence and who plan on returning to residence next year.

The function of the committee is to review rules, regulations, residence structures, life styles, etc. and to gather as much information as possible in these areas. It will meet on designated evenings within each of the residences to allow students there to make their views known. The committee members will be asked to make rec-

ommendations to the University Administration with a view to some changes being implemented by September of this year, if changes are required.

You will also be allowed to present written proposals to the committee. A questionnaire will be distributed which you are asked to complete and return. If you want to make any comments and wish to make sure that

they are strictly anonymous, then just address them to: Residence Review Committee and drop them into the mail room on the first floor of Main Building.

I sincerely hope that you will take advantage of this opportunity to express your views in a constructive way. Thanks for your anticipated co-operation.
