South dealer. East-West vulnerable. NORTH ♠ 8 4 3 ... SOUTH ♠ 6 ...

The bidding: South 1♠, North 1♥, South 2♥, North 3♥, South 4♥.

Opening lead—king of hearts. This hand appeared originally in the annual Intercollegiate Tournament. Par on the hand was for North-South to reach five clubs (the only game contract that can be made) and make it.

Many players are familiar with what is known as the loser on loser play, but a lesser number are acquainted with a different type of play where declarer substitutes a loser in one suit for a loser in another suit. The latter play is the theme that was stressed in this hand.

VANCOUVER (CP) — Eighty men paraded outside the Seafarers International Union headquarters Tuesday in what was described as a "protective picket."

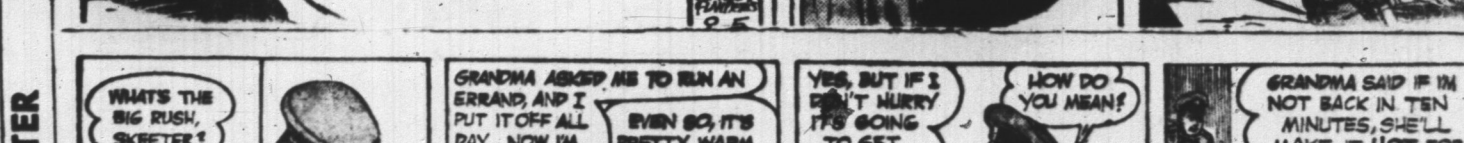
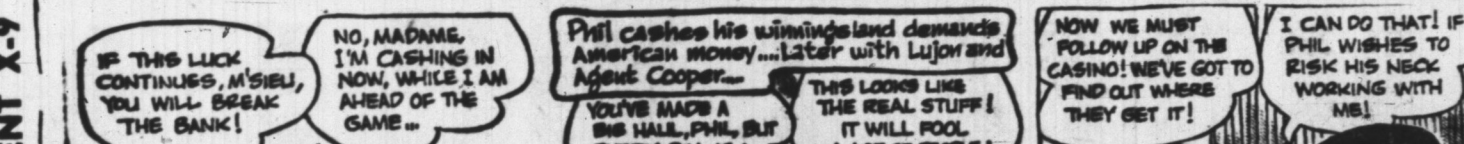
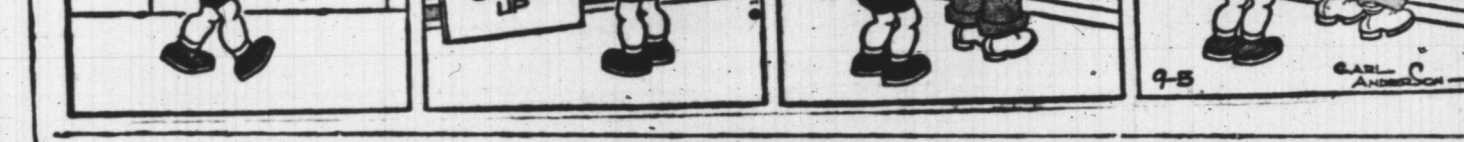
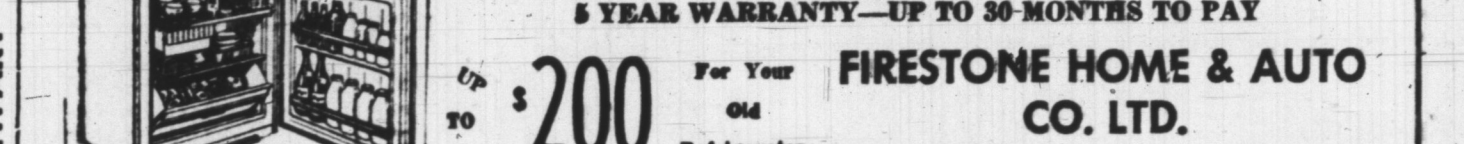
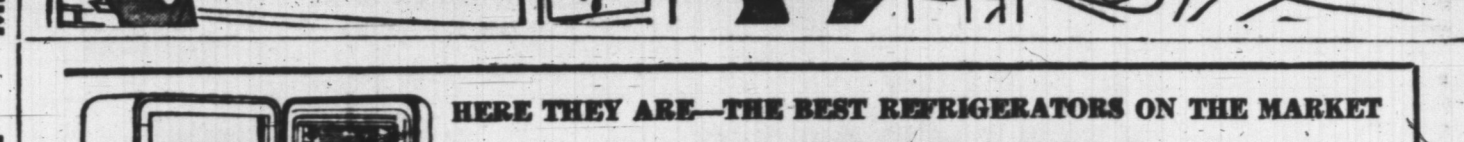
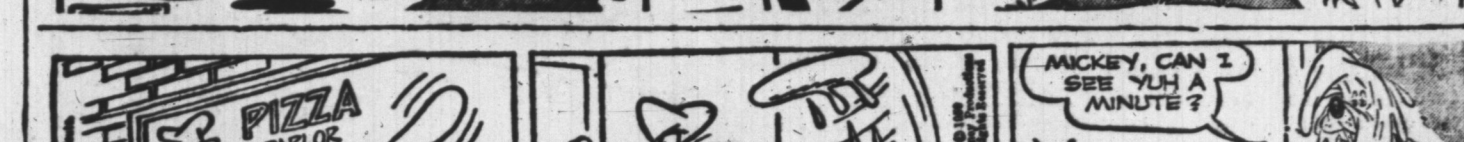
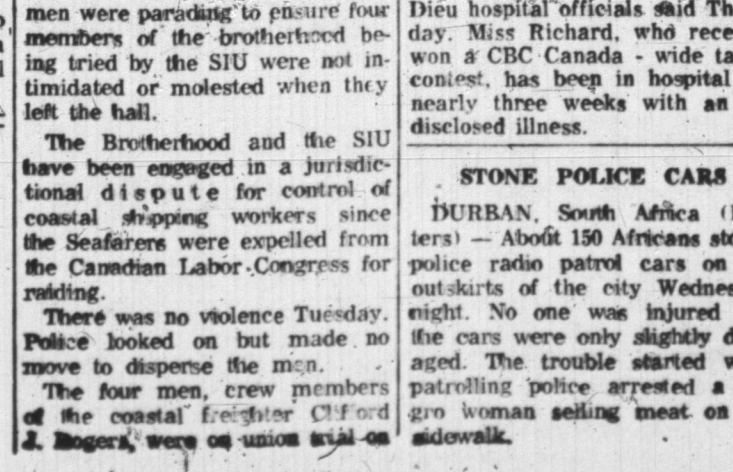
