Among selected industrial issues, Min. Loeb rose 1/2 to 28 1/2, Chrysler rose 1/4 to 25 1/4, and Alcan. Investors Syndicate and Massey-Ferguson each rose 1/4 to 31 cents.

Banks were mixed, Montreal and Royal both ahead 1/4 and National down 1/4 to 31 cents. Baker Paper is in firmer posture.

Speculative issues were dull. Under the Exchange index, gains of 143.16, western oils to 152.82, western oils 65 to 66 and base metals 17 to 18.

Volume for the day was 5,013,000 shares compared with 4,086,000 Tuesday.
