



Federal Authorities Seek Aid Enforcing Food, Drug Laws

OTTAWA (CP) — Federal authorities are asking consumers to help enforce food and drug laws.

The consumer division of the Food and Drug Directorate has produced a shiny new pamphlet telling consumers how they can help ensure safe foods, drugs and cosmetics.

The 35-page booklet provides a handy guide to the laws enacted by Parliament for consumer protection in these fields.

Then it urges them "to report to the consumer division all apparent infractions of the Food and Drug Act and regulations for the directorate's investigation."

"Honest mistakes are sometimes made by even the most conscientious manufacturers," says the booklet, "in the majority of cases they are grateful when this is drawn to their attention by a consumer and are quick to make redress."

There are times therefore when consumers should write manufacturers and make their grievances known.

"However, the consumer is encouraged to report to the directorate all evidence of irresponsible, fraudulent and unsanitary or otherwise dangerous practices."

CALL OFFICERS

Complaints should be sent to: The Consumer Division, Food and Drug Directorate, Department of National Health and Welfare, Ottawa. Or consumers should call in local food and drug officers from the five regional or 23 district offices spread from coast to coast.

Copies of the pamphlet "Food, drug, cosmetic protection for Canadians" can be obtained from the Ottawa address.

Complaints should state where and when the product was bought, the brand name, manufacturer's name and address from the label, and the code or lot identification stamped on tins or printed on labels.

The federal inspectors take it from there, checking samples of the product and taking corrective action. It may range from a warning to seizure and destruction of merchandise if the fault cannot be remedied.

If there's gross carelessness or wilful evasion of food and

drugs laws severe penalties may follow.

Besides investigating complaints about infractions of existing laws, the consumer division also says it welcomes hearing from consumers individually or in organized groups on new legislation.
