Modern CTC retail store opens in mall tomorrow

The Maritimes most modern Canadian Tire store and service center is scheduled to open Jan. 27 in the Royalty Mall, Upper Queen Street.

All fixtures and equipment in the new Canadian Tire Store are of the very latest design for the utmost in pleasant shopping and modern service for the automobile driver.

Where the previous store at 96 Queen Street had 3200 feet of customer area, Canadian Tire at Royalty Mall has 1200 feet of ground floor space plus a 4,000 foot mezzanine for storage and offices.

President of the new store is W.A. (Allison) MacRae; the vice-president is M.C. Stewart. Helen MacRae is secretary-treasurer.

Twenty employees will be on hand to serve Canadian Tire Corporation customers at the new store. This is in contrast with 17 years ago when Mr. Stewart and Mr. MacRae opened their Canadian Tire Corporation Associate store at 181 Great George Street on Jan. 27, 1949.

At that time there were no employees, only the two partners, one working full time and the other part time.

Later on that year Keith Robinson, now parts manager for

CTC came with the firm and in 1953 the space on Great George Street became inadequate and the business was moved to 96 Queen Street.

In 1954 the partnership was incorporated as Stewart and MacRae Ltd. and in 1959 a small service department was opened at the rear of the store at 95 Queen Street. Following acquisition of the property at 96-98 Queen Street in 1961, an extensive renovation was carried out as a result of two properties was integrated into a modern store.

The necessity of providing more complete service facilities to the growing number of CTC customers made it necessary for the management to once again plan for an expansion of Canadian Tire in Charlottetown. The new store is located in the Upper Queen and Lincoln Streets section of the Royalty Mall.

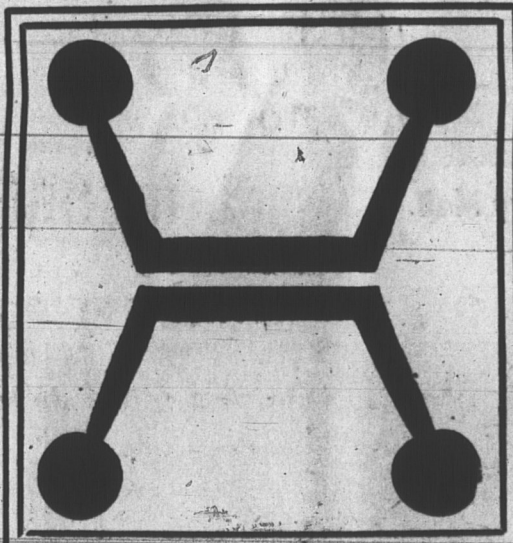
