Soviets Stress Building Of Fleet

MOSCOW, July 24 (AP)—Russia observed navy day this week with articles in the press declaring that British and American preparations and war threats make necessary the greatest strengthening of the Soviet fleet.

In a navy day article in the magazine Ogonok, Vice-Admiral N. I. Vinogradov said "the threat of war and preparations by American and English imperialists who dispose of large naval forces give rise with particular acuteness to the necessity of the broadest strengthening of our fleet."

He declared the creation of a separate navy ministry early last year at the personal initiative of Prime Minister Stalin was of primary significance.

Admiral Golovko wrote in Pravda that Stalin, the Soviet people, the Communist Party and the government are manifesting the

greatest concern in growth of the fleet, construction of new ships, and perfection of the training of sailors.

The Communist party newspaper's editorial said workers in the shipbuilding industry were putting forth all efforts to build more quickly and better new ships so as to supply the fleet with "battle power."
