His wife the former Florrie Ferguson predeceased him thirty three years ago. The beautiful floral tributes bore silent testimony of the love and respect of relatives and friends.

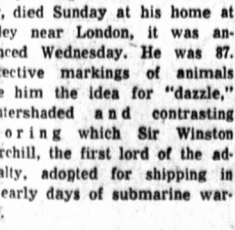
