Man in Car Accidents Kill 5

ANNAPOLIS ROYAL, N.S. (CP) — Helen Lynn Miller, 12, of Guinea, N.S., drowned Saturday in a pond at East Wolden, near here. RCMP said the girl drowned while swimming.

DOG ATTACKS LIGHT PLANE

CALGARY (CP) — A light aircraft was forced to make an emergency landing Friday after it was attacked by a dog and had its landing gear damaged.

Albe Thiessen of Strathmore, Alta., was crop spraying 15 miles southeast of Calgary. He said he was flying about three feet above the ground when a dog held by a marker leaped at the aircraft and attacked the left wheel.

The dog was killed and the undercarriage on the plane damaged.

Mr. Thiessen flew to Calgary's McCall field and made a landing on one wheel. The propeller and underside of the single-engine plane were damaged but not extensively. Mr. Thiessen was not injured.

Rains Quiet Forest Fires

TORONTO (CP) — An 11,000-acre blaze being fought by 500 men near Wawa, about 105 miles north of Sault Ste. Marie, was reported under control by the department of lands and forests Sunday.

Wawa and the nearby railroad town of Hawk Junction, both threatened by the fire earlier this week, have been classified as out of danger by the department.

Moderate rains east and south of Port Arthur have helped reduce the unusually high number of forest fires in the province. A report Friday showed 23 fires burning in Ontario, but Sunday the number was down to 15.

MANIWAKE, Que. (CP) — Day-long rains Sunday brought welcome relief to about 800 men battling a massive forest fire in this timber-rich area about 80 miles north of Ottawa.

Although not extinguished, the giant blaze that had already eaten up 11,000 acres of spruce and balsam, slogged under the soaking official of the Lower Ottawa Forest Protective Association said "the situation now is pretty good."

Near-Disaster Hits In Tunnel

GOLDEN, B.C. (CP) — Twenty-five men were taken to hospital and all but four were released by midday Sunday after treatment for carbon monoxide poisoning they suffered in a CPR railway tunnel Saturday.

It looked like a battle with bodies lying all over the "one ambulance, several station wagons and a number of parked department vehicles took the stricken men from the mouth of the tunnel.

Dr. J. E. Taylor and Dr. Gordon Lapp of Golden took over care of the poisoned men although medical assistance was called in from a nearby camp site and as far east as Banff before the extent of the emergency was known.

Some of them managed to reach the end of the tunnel before collapsing. Others had to be dragged out.

Blank Ballots Show Strong Peron Backing

BUENOS AIRES (AP) — An avalanche of blank ballots have voted for no one in one of the most confused elections in the country's history.

Peron, overthrown in 1955 and now living in Spain, sent out "blank" orders to about 3,000,000 followers. Such a vote could be considered backing for the return of Peron's welfare statism and possibly could take away any clear-cut victory for the three major candidates remaining in the race for president.

In the returns, a 62-year-old country doctor, Arturo Illia, took an early lead with 74,847 votes. Illia ran on the ticket of the Civic Union of People's Radicals. The figures included heavy returns from Cordova, Illia's home town.

Gen. Pedro Eugenio Aramburu, former president, trailed far behind with 18,221.

Cabinet Members Named in Sex Probe

LONDON (AP) — Three government ministers have been named as investigators Lord Denning is key figures in rumors of sex affairs in high places in the usual newspaper. The People says.

"It is alleged to show a member of the government, at the time of the Profumo case, in a group that includes Christine Keeler."

When announcing Denning's appointment, Macmillan spoke of rumors which affect the honor and integrity of public life and which, if true, would point to a security risk.
