(AS); **Red-bellied Woodpecker** - 1 at Parkdale feeder on Dec. 14 (CMC); **Pileated Woodpecker** - 1 at Stratford on Jul. 20 (ML), 1 at Johnson's River on Sept. 8 (JWar); **Black-backed Woodpecker** - 1 in Selkirk on Nov. 18 (GM); **Flycatchers** - group in tree in early Oct. in Battery Point (WP), 5 to 6 at Mt. Herbert taking flies of edge of roof and window on Oct. 18 as well as grasshoppers in field (TR); **Gray Jay** - 1 at Clarkin on Oct. 12 (BH); **American Crow** - approx. 500 on Rocky Point beach literally blackening the shore between 4:30 & 5:00 pm on Oct. 27 (LD), estimated roost of 4,500 at Victoria Park evening of Nov. 1 (BD); **White-breasted Nuthatch** - 1 at Keppock feeder on Dec. 7-11 (B&RH); **Red-breasted Nuthatch** - 1 at Rocky Pt. feeder most of Oct. (LD); **Golden-crowned Kinglet & Ruby-crowned Kinglet** - at Churchill Woodlot on Oct. 19 (BH); **Cedar Waxwing** - 4 feeding in white spruce daily in late Nov. & early Dec. at West Royalty (LK); **Northern Shrike** - 1 at Dalvay Pond on Oct. 24 (PA), 1 attacking birds at Rocky Point feeder on Nov. 8 (LD), 1 at Fort Amherst on Nov. 10 (CS), 1 at Monticello on Nov. 12 (GM); **Yellow Warbler** - ♀ at Fullerton's Marsh on Oct. 19 (RT); **Yellow-rumped Warbler** - 1 on Oct. 15 at Sherwood (RC), 1 at PEI National Park on Dec. 22 (DO); **Ovenbird** - 1 at Bunbury on Nov. 31 (R&JT); **Yellow-headed Blackbird** - 1 at Fort Augustus from Nov. 8 to Dec. 1 (AM, MK, CH); **Red-winged Blackbird** - ♂ at Rocky Point on Oct. 19 (LD), 2 at Graham's Pond on Dec. 3 (GJ, VMac); **Baltimore Oriole** - 1 1st year ♂ at Monticello feeder from Nov. 18 to Dec. 15 (GM, M&JM); **Common Grackle** - 8 in Sherwood on Nov. 4 (RC); **Dickcissel** - 1 at New Dominion on Dec. 14 (PC); **White-throated Sparrow** - 6 to 8 at Bunbury for 2-3 days in Mod-Oct.
