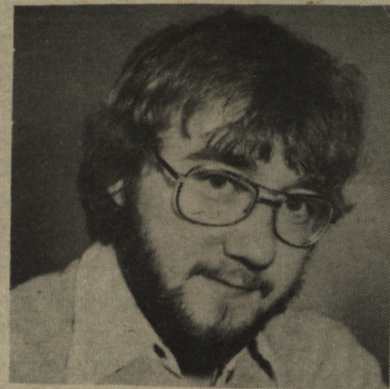

It is my feeling that this line of direct communication could better serve and represent our student body.

There are other main issues, some of which are: The Student Bursary Fund, the parking situation on campus, The Landlord and Tenant Act, pay increases within our Union, and the situation with regard to our Student Union Building.

I would encourage you to attend the speeches, and to feel free to come to talk with me about your concerns and ideas for our Student Union.

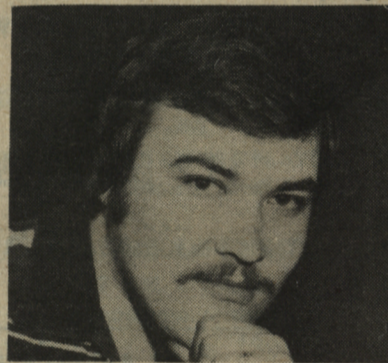


Kevin Gauthier - President

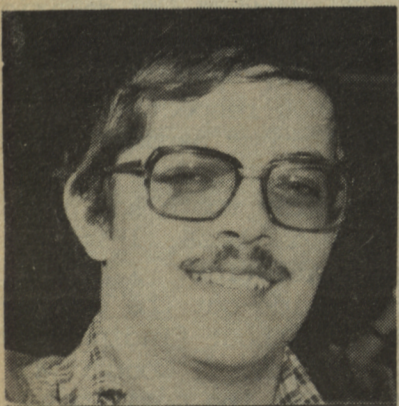

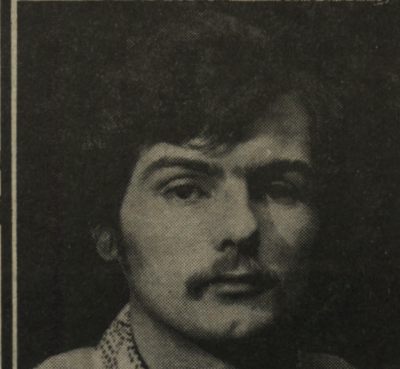
