Red Wings Shade Blakemen 3-2

MONTREAL (CP) — Detroit Red Wings outskated Montreal Canadiens most of the way Saturday night for a 3-2 win that was bolstered by steadier goal-tending.
The win gave Detroit second place in the National Hockey League race, one point ahead of Toronto Maple Leafs and seven behind the leading Canadiens.
Alex Delvecchio put Detroit in front in the first period and Val Fonteyne and Gary Alderson set up a 3-1 lead in the second. Masked goalie Jacques Plante of Montreal looked anything but good on the second-period goals that proved enough for the win.
Detroit goalie Terry Sawchuk was beaten by Phil Goyette's tip-in deflection in the second period, and late in the last period when Jean Beliveau scored on a short rebound. It was Beliveau's 15th goal of the season.
A crowd of 13,988 saw Canadiens' winless streak reach four

straight, two losses and two ties, while the Red Wings built up an undefeated run of four on three wins and a tie.
Saturday's win was the first for Detroit over Montreal this season, against three losses and three ties.
Delvecchio golfed a 20-footer to score at 15:33 of the first period, the puck dropping at his feet when Norm Ullman's pass was deflected into the air.
Goyette deflected Billy Hicke's shot past Sawchuk at 3:37 of the

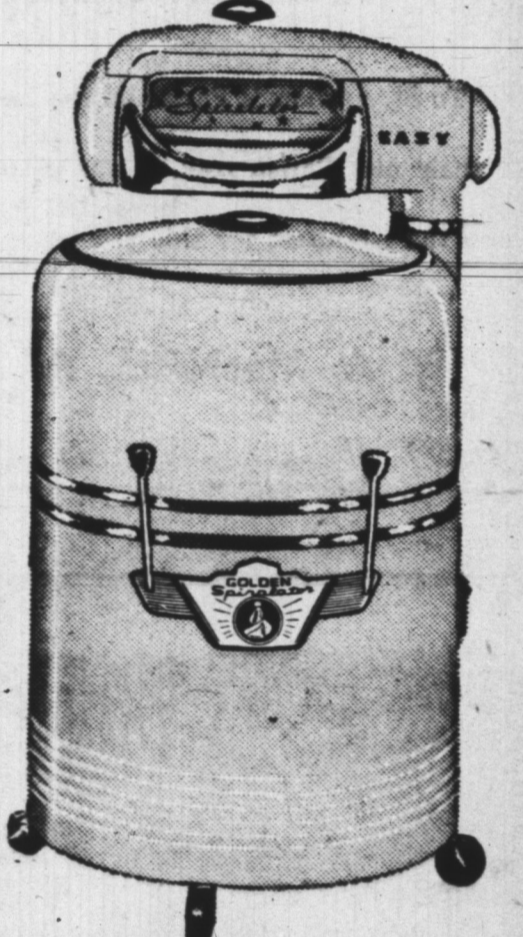
