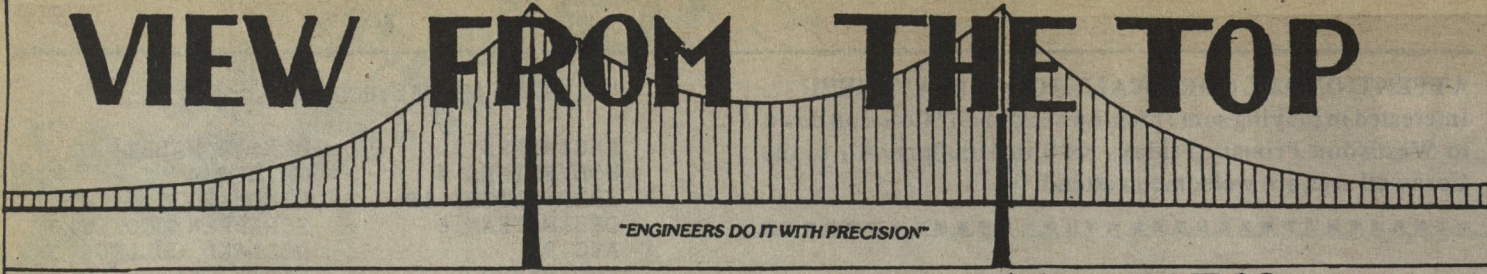

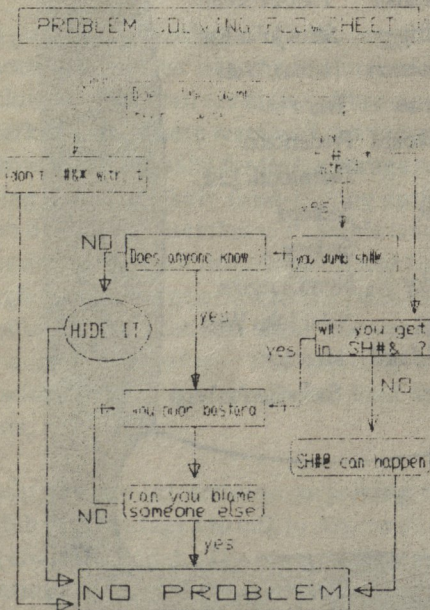
ENGINEERING SOCIETY NEWS

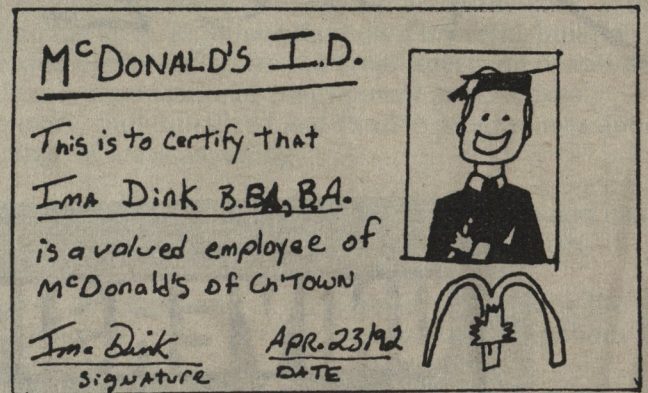
TOP 10 WAYS TO DEAL WITH STRESS:
