

Horse Notes.

Previous to his mile in 2.19 at St. Louis, Axtel had not won a harness for 4 weeks, and to show with what good judgment Williams handled the colt it may be noted that at St. Louis he announced that he would just beat 2.20, carrying a watch in his hand and doing the distance in 2.19. Then came the mile in 2.14 at Terre Haute, and another one, three days later, in 2.12. If this does not show that the majority of colts are overtrained we should like to know what does. Williams did not start Barnhart, two-year-old brother to Allerton, at Lexington. The colt can trot in 2.40, but this was not fast enough to get any part of the money. The latest in regard to Axtel is that Budd Doble has acquired an interest in the colt, and will accompany him on the journey to California, soon to be made by Axtel, Jack, the pacer Johnston, and Heylin, a three-year-old son of Hermes, that is owned by a syndicate of wealthy men in Cleveland, who want the colt to have the benefit of Doble's training. Heylin was in Cape Stinson's string at the Cleveland track until that trainer abandoned his charges to take hold of the colt belonging to Miller & Sibley, and could show close to a 2.20 gait.

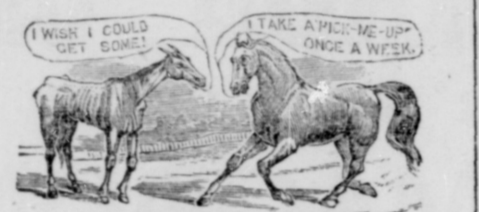
