TORONTO (CP) — The stock market, featured by golds Thursday closed on an irregular note after a session of moderately active trading. A few minutes after Inco's dividend-announcement appeared on the tape the stock dipped to 25 1/2 points, its low for the day and a loss of 1 1/2 points.

Golds, for the second straight session, forged ahead against the trend. Gains ranged to a point among senior issues and to 45 cents in the lower-priced list. Few losses were recorded and these were generally less than 10 cents.

Senior and junior base metals, particularly lead and zinc stocks, slipped a bit after a Washington report said the United States tariff commission had recommended an increase on tariffs of lead and zinc.

Index changes: Golds up 1.63 to 82.50; base metals off .84 to 146.95; western oils up .15 to 127.54.
