\$11,000 Poetry Contest

Poets may enter the American Poetry Association's nationwide contest now. Over \$11,000 in prizes will be awarded to 152 winners. Entry is free and everyone is welcome to enter.

The Grand Prize is \$1,000 and the First Prize is \$500. Other prizes include cash awards and publication.

"Students walked away with 24 prizes in our last contest," said Robert Nelson, publisher for the Association. "I urge every student who writes poetry to enter now - before studies and exams take up your time. Ypoung people with talent should get encouragement and recognition while

they are still young."

Poets may enter the contest by sending up to six poems, each no more than 20 lines, name and address on each page, to American Poetry Association, Dept. CT-70, 250-A Potrero Street, P.O. Box 1803, Santa Cruz, CA 95061-1803. Poems must be postmarked by December 31.

Each poem is also considered for publication in the American Poetry Anthology, a leading collection of contemporary verse.

During seven years of sponsorship the American Poetry Association has run 32 contests and awarded over \$145,000 in prizes to 3,040 winning poets.

Model UN Meeting

The UPEI Model United Nations Association will hold an information meeting on Tuesday, October 17 at 5:30 pm in the Robertson Library Lecture Theatre.

Because of its unique location, New York City, the Model United Nations Simulation affords its participants a week of memorable experiences. Students learn about UN procedures and act as delegates of their nation during the simulation.

This spring UPEI students will be simulating two countries, one of which is Japan. Through a special agreement, UPEI and Japanese students will work together to simulate Japanese policies in New York. The Japanese students will be on PEI a week before the actual simulation to meet their Island colleagues. The second country has not been decided as of yet. It will most likely be a third world country.

This spring's simulation takes place April 10-14. The delegation will be leaving for New York on Sunday, April 8 and arriving home on Easter Sunday, April 15. A note of caution to students this is 2 days before exams start.

This credit course is open to students from all disciplines. It is not limited to political studies majors or arts students. Science, business, music, and education students are strongly encouraged to apply. There are no prerequisites. However, the course is not open to freshmen. Sophomores are especially welcome.
