CCF Farm Spokesman Asks New Floor Price For Eggs

OTTAWA (CP) — Hazen Argue, CCF farm spokesman, Wednesday proposed a new federal price support program for eggs which, he said, would assure producers of a floor price for all eggs going into interprovincial trade.

Referring to eggs, the minister said that under the constitution provincial co-operation would be required to maintain a floor price under all eggs.

Mr. Gardiner used the occasion to elaborate on his announcement Tuesday night that a floor price will be put under first grade dried skimmed milk.
