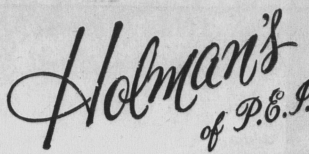


Saturday Minor Hockey Results

Hawks Topple Sherbrooke 5-3

SHERBROOKE, Que. (CP)— A three-goal drive in the final period carried Moncton Hawks to a 5-3 win over Sherbrooke Beavers Sunday and gave the Maritimers a 20 lead in their best-of-five Eastern Canada Allan Cup semi-final series.
 Ron Gaudet, Doug Howatt and burly defenceman Georges Roy all counted for the Hawks in the final 20 minutes. Gaudet got the first one, Howatt clicked

while teammate Hartley Estabrook was in the penalty box and Roy rounded it out by dumping the puck into an empty net after Sherbrooke goalie Joe Lacourriere was lifted for a sixth attacker.
 The Beavers outdid Moncton 35-29, taking a 2-0 lead in the opening period and emerging from the second period with a 2-2 edge.
 Third game in the set is to be played here tonight. Oscar Gaudet and Phil Doron counted. Moncton's second period goals by Claude Cardin, Larry Drouin and Rejean Hamelin shared in the Sherbrooke scoring.
 The Hawks' goal came 51 seconds after the start of the game. He drew three of the four minor penalties imposed against Sherbrooke. The Hawks were tagged with five minors.

SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico (AP)— Lightweight boxing champion Carlos Ortiz was taken ill Saturday and his 15-round title fight with Doug Gallant of Cuba, scheduled for Saturday night, was postponed at least until today.

Ortiz, a 28-year-old Puerto Rican-born New Yorker, was stricken with stomach pains during the night and called doctors when he began vomiting. The doctors said the champion was suffering from gastroenteritis, caused by a virus or tension, or both.

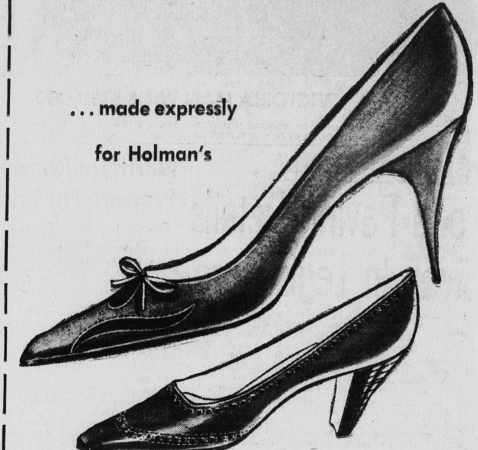
