National Retail Credit Week Being Observed
 This being national Retail Credit Week, the Credit Bureau of operation with the Credit Bureau of Charlottetown are participating in the annual campaign to remind us how this modern economic instrument of credit can be used to promote our own well being. National Retail Credit Week is sponsored by the National Retail Credit Association with some 600 companies participating. According to literature put out by N.R.C.A., it would take months - maybe years - for many of us to save enough to pay cash for that refrigerator, piano, automobile, or household furniture. The dress or suit we want today might not be available until next week or next month. Lacking the cash, we might even have to put off a visit to the physician, dentist or hospital.

Credit is the magic force that puts the good things of life within the immediate reach of responsible people. It enables us to buy now and pay at a more convenient time. It also enables us to get more for our money. The expanded purchasing power created by credit results in mass production and that in turn lowers manufactured goods. In Charlottetown as in so many other communities, the extension of retail credit facilities by the services of our local Retail Credit Bureau.

With complete files on how individual credit accounts are being paid the bureau facilitates rapid credit service to those entitled to it. At the same time, of course, the bureau acts as a brake on those who would abuse their credit responsibilities.

If your record on file at the bureau is good, you will find it easy to establish your credit with new people in a new neighborhood or even in different cities and it may help you in other directions, too. For a good credit record is a mark of character in business circles. Your credit record is, indeed, an open book in which credit granters read how trustworthy you are. It pays to keep this record straight. National Retail Credit Week is intended to remind all of us to do just that.

Liquor, Cigarets Seized On Ship
 MONTREAL (CP) - A squad of RCMP early Friday ended a search of the Swedish-American line ship Vretaholm with the seizure of 524 bottles of contraband liquor and eight cartons of cigarettes.

An officer from the ship must appear in court and the line will be required to post \$800 before the ship can leave port.

Police said the liquor - rum and cognac - apparently had been obtained in Havana, Cuba, and Vera Cruz, Mexico. It was found in water tanks near the propeller housing and in a secret compartment in an officer's quarters.
