PEI Advisory Council on the Status of Women -- Bursary For a Woman Student. This bursary is awarded annually to female students of Holland College or UPEI who are enrolled in full-time studies. To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria: be able to demonstrate a financial need; be out of school for at least two full years; and complete the Advisory Council's application form. Application forms may be picked up at Student Services and are to be postmarked no later than November 15, 1995.

PEI Union of Public Sector Employees (\$500). This bursary is awarded annually by the PEI Union of Public Sector Employees to: (1) its members or (2) dependants of members or retired members. The UPSE Public Relations Committee will base its decision on three factors of importance which, in order of importance are:

(1) financial need, (2) academic ability, (3) UPSE involvement as a member or by the member of whom the applicant is a dependant. When applications are reviewed, it will be done in a "blind test" procedure by whereby Committee members will not be aware of the applicant's names. The deadline for applications is December 1, 1995.
