Mrs. Anna Robertson, Red Point visited recently with her aunt, Mrs. John McKie, Howe Point.

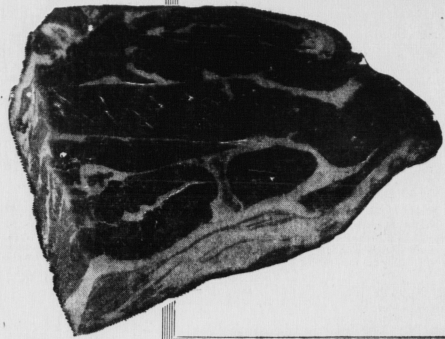

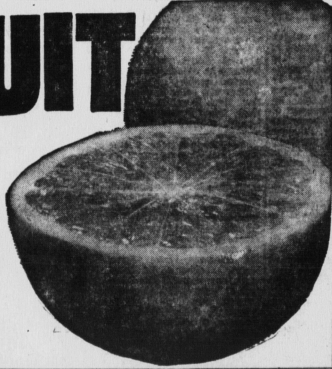
