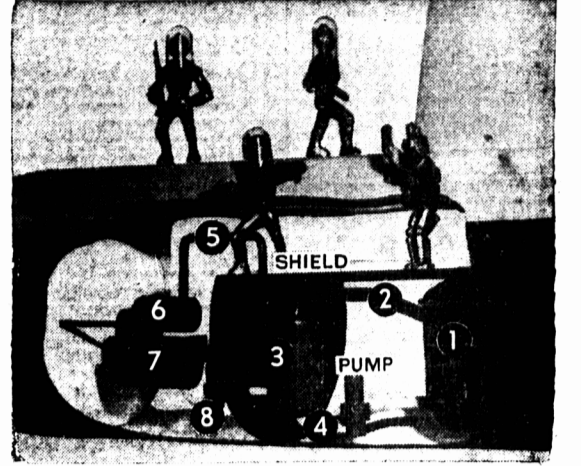

Here's How Atomic Sub Would Work



This five-foot model of the USS Nautilus, world's first atomic-energy-powered submarine, is on display in Chicago's Museum of Science and Industry. The figures, in futuristic costume, symbolize scientific advances incorporated in the craft. A closeup of the power plant, above, shows how the engine works. Nuclear reaction creates heat in the atomic "reactor" (1), sending hot fluid through pipe (2) to steam generator-powered turbine (3). Turbine (3) returns fluid to the "furnace" through pipe (4). Steam goes through pipe (5) to steam turbine (6) which turns propeller shaft seen at the extreme left. Condensed steam (water) goes into tank (7) where, by the engine works. Nuclear reaction creates heat in the atomic "reactor" (8) which is returned to the pump.

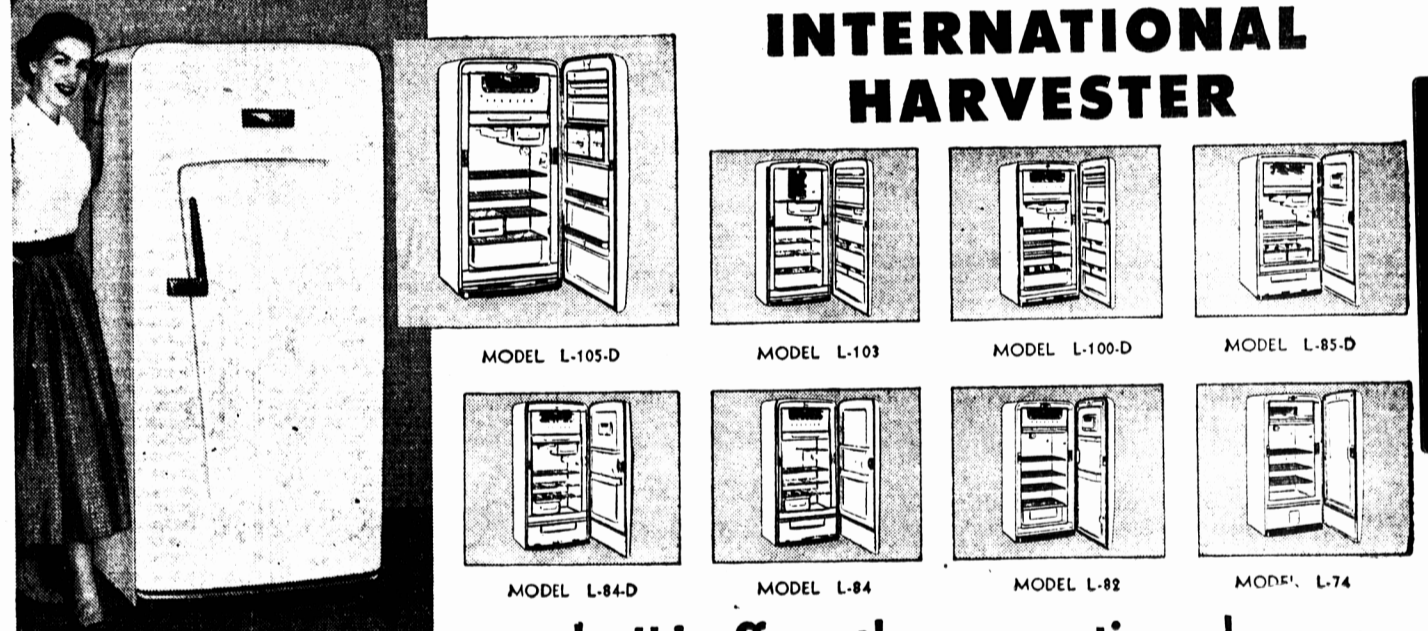

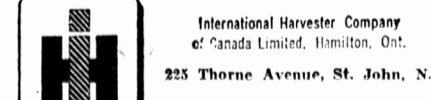
