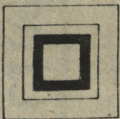

Listed below are a few scholarships you might be interested in. If you are not studying in these areas and need financial assistance please come to see me in Student services, first floor Main Building. I'll be glad to explore possible sources with you. Federal-Provincial Programme of Bilingualism in Education

Summer Language Bursary Programme. Total immersion in the second official language at an educational institution. Individual grants are approximately \$1000 to cover tuition and living expenses.

Parliamentary Internships

This programme is open to men and women 21-35 years of age who

are graduates with a degree in political science, history, law, economics, business administration, or other social sciences. This is for a period of 10 months and pays approximately \$8,000.

Deadline: Early January, 1982.

The MacEwen Undergraduate Scholarship

This is for study in Scotland at the University of St. Andrews. The applicants must be a Canadian resident who is of Scottish ancestry, or is the son or daughter of an alumnus of the University of St. Andrews. The scholarship is tenable for a three-year course of studies toward the ordinary degree or a four year course toward an honours degree. It will cover all tuition fees and residence costs and a stipend for basic expenses. You must not be more than 21 years of age and must be attending university in Canada or be qualified for admission to a university in Canada. The winner will be chosen on the basis of academic achievement and leadership potential.
