SOURIS SHIPS FILLETS TO B.C.

SOURIS — Fish products out of Souris will, for the first time, reach clear across the country to the west coast. It was announced last night by an official of Eastern Fisheries Ltd. in Souris.

Yesterday, 70,000 pounds of frozen fillets, an amount equal to what is normally carried in three trailer truck loads, was loaded aboard the first self-refrigerated car ever used in Kings County in preparation for shipment to Vancouver.

Up until this time all fish shipped in Canada from Souris went to the other Maritime Provinces or to Ontario and Quebec. About 75 per cent of the fish shipped from Souris goes to the United States.

267 Are Tested At St. Eleanors

ST. ELEANORS — For the first time in a series of five Lions glaucoma clinics held in the province so far, there were no cases of glaucoma discovered when a total of 267 persons were examined at the St. Eleanors clinic yesterday afternoon and evening.

The total taking the test so far is 1,549 and the actual number of cases found in the four clinics held earlier remains at 23.
