WINNIPEG (CP) — Prices were firm at the close Thursday on the Winnipeg grain exchange after holding to a narrow range throughout the dull session.

Can wheat export loadings of Canadian wheat included 815,000 bushels to Germans, 400,000 to South Africa, 170,000 to the United Kingdom, 85,000 to Brazil and 10,000 to Colombia.

Lakehead prices for the top grades of class two, IWA and domestic wheat advanced one-quarter cent from Wednesday except class two durum which were unchanged.
