Mrs. Henry Wyson, of Horton, Kansas, attempted to kill herself on Friday night.

In a tenement house situated in the Italian quarter of Chicago and occupied by some fifty families, representing Greece, Italy, Arabia and Africa, a drunken free fight occurred a few nights ago among the inmates.

Bartholomew Sullivan, a farmer, was hanged at Tralee, Ireland, a few days ago, for complicity in the murder of Patrick Flahive, an evicted farmer at Ballyhague, Kerry, last August.

A serious accident occurred on the Grand Trunk, near Kingston, Ont., on the 2nd inst. Two freight trains collided with much force at Ballantyne, smashing twenty-six cars and two locomotives.

John A. Markbow, a Holyoke, Mass., hackman, shot, and it is thought, fatally wounded his wife on the evening of the 2nd.
