

Student-in-Industry lives!

CHARLOTTETOWN, P.E.I. — Minister of Industry, Pat Binns has announced renewed funding for the Student-in-Industry program for 1984.

This program, which has operated over the past ten years, offers incentive to Island businesses to hire students and employ them in the areas of their learned management disciplines.

Besides giving the hiring companies a financial break in wages paid, the program is an inexpensive and innovative job creation method aimed primarily at the age group with the highest unemployment rate.

The program is co-ordinated through the University of Prince Edward Island's School of Business, which

helps the department match the best qualified student to the job description submitted by the employing company.

Last year there were 26 applications and 17 Island firms successfully participated in the program.

In all, a total of 19 students were employed with two cases of a job being shared between two students at various times during the summer. The program created 212 weeks of employment at an average weekly wage of \$203.65.

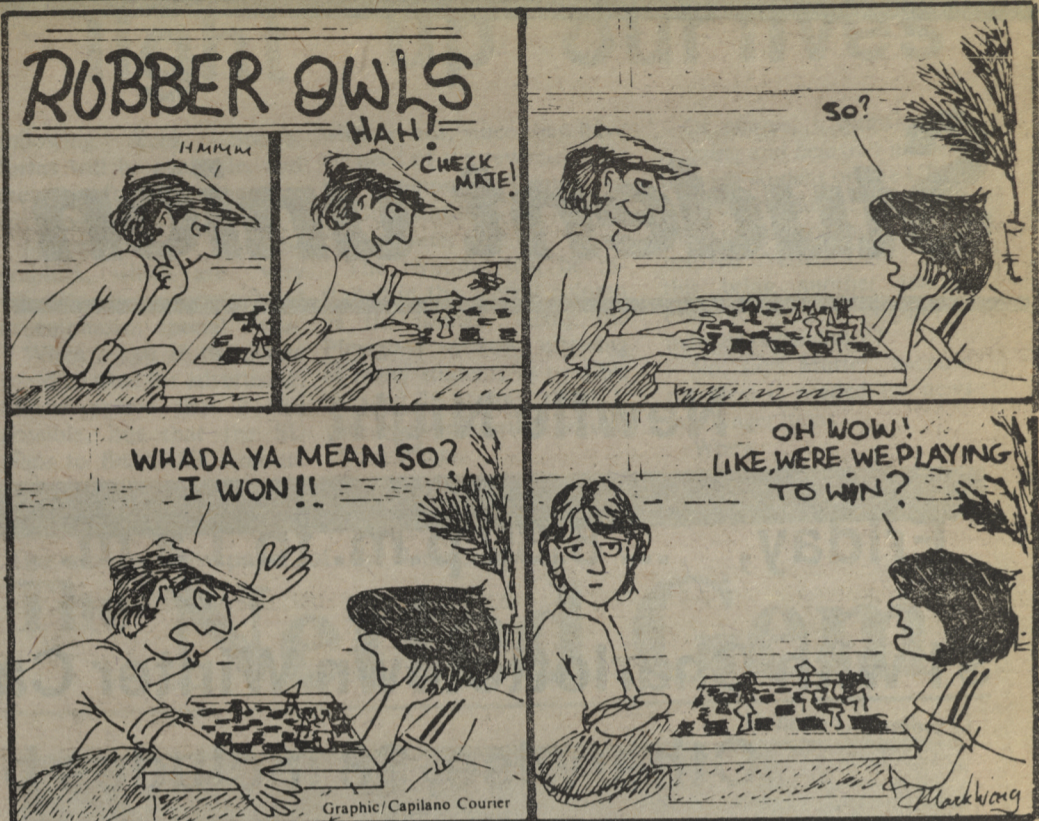
Binns noted that the program provided valuable experience for all 19 students, both in their own specific disciplines and in the broader management field.

"The Island firms which participated and the U.P.E.I. School of Business, which

helped us to match the proper students to the jobs, are to be applauded for their participation", he said. "Without their cooperation and support, the Student-in-Industry program would not have been possible".

Binns explained that "matches between the student and the job are not always possible because of distances and/or the uniqueness of either the individual or the position, and therefore students could not be placed with all applicant companies".

The Minister also stated that he was pleased with the number of applicants and that the 1984 program would be advertised by his department later this month.
